SKOCH Renaissance AWARD 2014

The Skoch Renaissance Award is conferred upon corporates which demonstrate outstanding business leadership while simultaneously contributing to India's socio-economic growth. It recognises top performing State owned, Private, Public and Multinational corporations, in India, which create a significant regional, national or international impact with their business practices.

The Skoch Renaissance Award considers corporate entities that have contributed significantly to India's growth through an exemplary, sustainable & balanced business performance. The organisation should have exhibited strong business leadership, a commitment to improving the sector they operate in by value creation for all stakeholders, business process and quality enhancement, skill development, employment generation and being a good corporate citizen.

METHODOLOGY

- Selected applicants may also be called for evaluation presentation during November 2014 at New Delhi.
- A merit list of Top National applicants to be released by 1st Week of November 2014
- Merit listed applicants to showcase and receive *Skoch Order of Merit* in New Delhi on 20th November 2014.
- Finalist will be chosen from among the merit listed applicants. Skoch Renaissance to be conferred on 21st November 2014 in New Delhi.
- Attendance during the evaluation presentation and 38th Skoch summit is mandatory to qualify for the award.

As a part of the process an awards committee is formed consisting of professionals from the industry. Additional information, if required, would be sought and may be supplemented with Skoch's own research or the knowledge base of awards committee. Public voting is solicited for wider stakeholder consultation and gets a weightage determined by the awards committee depending on the nature of the initiative. The awards committee then deliberates and decides on the awardees. The committee may also nominate organisations/initiatives in special categories that it feels should be considered by the awards committee depending on the nature or people of the project.

- Nominations must reach by 17:00 hours IST, on 31st October 2014. Nominations received by 20th October 2014 will get 10 percent additional points.
- Each submission must include: A completed Nomination Form / Project Information as per the enclosed format.
